When Sunrise Haven’s new building opened in 2001 in Kent, Washington, it was clear that it was designed and constructed not only for practicality and function but also with spiritual qualities in mind such as light, inspiration, receptivity and love.

Since then, Christian Science nursing has been fulfilling its mission many times over through Sunrise Haven’s healing atmosphere and the Christian Science nurses’ skilled, loving care.

Everyone working at Sunrise Haven gains inspiration daily from our Leader, Mary Baker Eddy, who speaks of the glorious blessings that come from the desire to do good and to share. She writes, “As an active portion of one stupendous whole, goodness identifies man with universal good” (Mary Baker Eddy, *First Church of Christ, Scientist, and Miscellany* 165:16-18).

While Sunrise Haven’s facility has been lovingly maintained over the past 15 years, it is now showing some obvious wear and tear. Vinyl flooring, carpet and interior paint need to be updated and/or replaced.

“It is our goal to match the skilled, loving Christian Science nursing care provided at Sunrise Haven with the highest standard of excellence in the appearance and function of our facility. We are excited about getting our beautiful building all polished up!” said Executive Director Robin Banko.

This fall, Sunrise Haven launched a new campaign to raise \$88,000 for renovations to the building. “We are so grateful to be well on our way to meeting our goal,” said Banko, “since we recently received a generous offer to match, dollar for dollar, every contribution made through the end of 2016 up to \$88,000. In order to start the project we need to have all the funds in hand, so we are hoping to achieve our goal by year-end.”

Sunrise Haven Outreach Workshops – Billings, Montana

Sunrise Haven visited Billings early in 2016 and gave a workshop, Discovering the Comforter Within, to an enthusiastic group who were interested in learning more about caring for church members as well as loved ones at home. Two additional presentations were also given, one on Advance Directives and the other on Medicare Choices for Christian Scientists. Attendees learned how Medicare may cover some Christian Science nursing care at facilities like Sunrise Haven.

On August 1, 2016, Sunrise Haven representatives returned to Billings to present a seminar titled, “The Spiritual Dimension of Care.” This seminar focuses on the important role Christian Science nursing plays in our church’s healing mission for humanity. Some attendees traveled long distances to be there. One person drove over 400 miles! Following the seminar, at least two attendees expressed interest in Christian Science nursing training.
